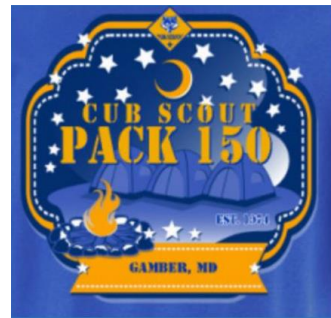


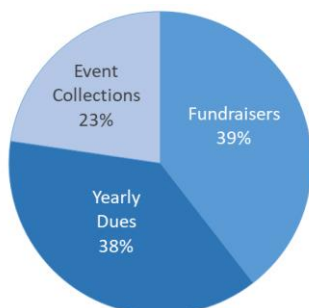

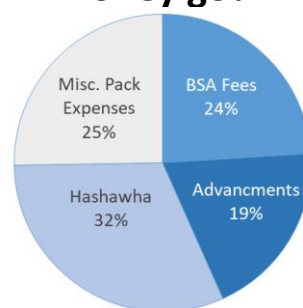
2021-2022 Pack Dues

Where does the money come from?



- The pack's main source of income is fundraising. Our top fundraisers are popcorn and chocolate bars, but we will have other fundraisers throughout the year. **Fundraising is very important to keep the cost of scouts down!!**
- Event collections are fees we collect per scout for events the pack has to pay for. About 90% of all event collections are for Hashawha.

Where does the money go?



- BSA fees, which increased in 2020, make up about a quarter of the pack's total expenses.
- Advancement merchandise like hats, belt loops, and neckerchiefs make up about 20% of the total expenses.
- Hashawha is always the pack's biggest expense for the year. About 45% of Hashawha is funded by fundraising.

The 2021-2022 Yearly Pack Dues will remain **\$120 per scout this year.**

- This will cover 100% of the BSA fees and about 90% of the cost of advancements for each scout.
- All other costs will be covered via fundraising and event collections.
- The due date for pack dues is September 30th.

How to Pay

Pack 150 has moved to electronic payments!! All pack payments will be made online using the website shown below. You will be able to pay for your yearly dues, event fees, and pack merchandise such as the pack T-Shirt, online by credit card or eCheck (ACH).
